What does it mean?

1. What is the flow of thought that leads into these two verses?
2. When Peter makes reference to suffering a "little while", to what time period is he making reference?
3. What is Peter trying to communicate by "the God of all grace"? Why doesn't he just say "God"?
4. What is God's "eternal glory"? What does it mean that we have been "called" to it?
5. What does it mean to be restored, confirmed, strengthened and established by God?

How does it apply?

1. Where have you been suffering the most lately?
2. When you think of God, what are the first things that pop into your head?
3. How do you picture God's eternal glory? What emotions do you think you will have when you fully experience it?
4. Describe a time when God restored you. What happened? Confirmed? Strengthened? Established?
5. How confident are you that God will accomplish all He has promised? How do you know?
