1. What do you find interesting and significant about the context in which this parable was told?
2. Jesus asked the lawyers and Pharisees if it's lawful to heal on the Sabbath. They remained silent. Why?
3. What message is Jesus intending to send by asking them whether or not they would pull their son or ox out of a well on the Sabbath?
4. What does the Pharisees repeated silence convey?
5. What precipitated Jesus' telling of the parable?
6. What is the big idea of the parable?
7. How does God "exalt the humble"?

How does it apply?

1. Have you ever been in a social setting where the conversation became awkward when a substantial issue was discussed? How did it make you feel? How did you respond?
2. Have you ever been tempted to bend a principle of faith because it made your life easier? What happened?
